The MPower project provides practical training opportunities in transferrable STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) skills, particularly for those from underprivileged backgrounds. MPower is working with a range of stakeholders to develop training facilities for the low carbon, engineering, construction and rail industries in St Blazey. Our learners gain hands-on experience whilst restoring and regenerating important Cornish industrial heritage infrastructure and equipment. At the heart of the Cornish rail network, the MPower site is easily accessible by public transport via Par Station. MPower is helping to alleviate structural inequality and promote social mobility for the deprived community of Cornwall.
